Top Five in WCHA Standings Gain Just One Collective Point Friday; Michigan Tech Triumphs at DU; Minnesota, Alaska Anchorage, Minnesota State Post Victories to Stay in Hunt for Home Ice Bemidji State, Colorado College Tie; St. Cloud State Earns Draw with North Dakota; Sioux Own Two-Point Lead in Race for MacNaughton Cup; Six Teams Separated by Four Points

MADISON, Wis. – It was a night of surprises on Friday (Feb. 18) as the current top five teams in the Western Collegiate Hockey Association men's standings gained just one collective point among them as league-leading North Dakota played to a 3-3 (ot) tie at St. Cloud State. Elsewhere, second place Denver fell 3-2 to visiting Michigan Tech, third place (tie) Minnesota Duluth dropped a 3-1 decision at Minnesota State, third place (tie) Nebraska Omaha was upended 3-2 at Alaska Anchorage and fifth place Wisconsin suffered a 5-2 defeat at the hands of visiting Minnesota.

As a result, North Dakota is still the only team to have clinched a first round home WCHA playoff berth heading into Saturday (Feb. 19) play and 10 other teams remain in contention for the remaining five first round home berths.

Today's six conference match ups have North Dakota (21-8-3, 16-6-1 WCHA) taking on host St. Cloud State (12-14-5, 8-11-4 WCHA) at the National Hockey Center, defending MacNaughton Cup champion Denver (18-8-5, 14-6-3 WCHA) entertaining Michigan Tech (4-23-4, 2-19-2 WCHA) at Magness Arena at 7:07 pm MT, Minnesota Duluth (18-7-5, 13-6-4 WCHA) taking on host Minnesota State (14-13-6, 8-13-4 WCHA) at Verizon Wireless Center, Nebraska Omaha (18-11-2, 14-7-2 WCHA) facing-off at 7:07 pm AT against Alaska Anchorage (11-15-3, 10-13-2 WCHA) at Sullivan Arena, Wisconsin (19-11-3, 11-10-2 WCHA) again hosting Minnesota (13-12-4, 10-10-3 WCHA) at 8:07 pm CT the Kohl Center, and Colorado College (17-14-2, 11-11-1 WCHA) skating against host Bemidji State (11-14-4, 7-12-4 WCHA) at Sanford Center.

In non-conference play, Alaska Anchorage will engage in-state rival Alaska Fairbanks in a home-and-home Alaska Airlines Governor's Cup series. Minnesota State will be idle.

Friday, February 18 Highlights

Michigan Tech 3 @ Denver 2 (WCHA): Center Patrick McFadden had a shorthanded goal and an assist, left winger Ryan Furne scored the eventual game-winner with his club a man-down at 8:38 of the second period, and Kevin Genoe made 23 saves between the pipes as visiting Michigan Tech defeated Denver 3-2 before a crowd of 5,625 at Magness Arena. The victory, the first for the Huskies since Oct. 15, also gave them a 1-0-0 advantage in the season series. Other goals in the game came from MTU's Bryce Reddick and DU's Matt Donovan and Drew Shore.

North Dakota 3 @ St. Cloud State 3 ot (WCHA): Right winger Matt Frattin scored two goals, including a game-tying marker at 16:29 of the third period, as visiting North Dakota overcame three successive goals by St. Cloud State to gain a 3-3 (ot) tie before a sellout crowd of 6,011 at the National Hockey Center. Leading 2-0 midway through the second, the Sioux saw the Huskies score three straight, including a go-ahead power-play goal from left winger Ben Hanowski at 9:12 of the third. UND leads the season series, 2-0-1.

Nebraska Omaha 2 @ Alaska Anchorage 3 (WCHA): Center Daniel Naslund's goal at 10:06 of the third period held up as the game-winner and Rob Gunderson made 22 saves as the host Seawolves claimed a 3-2 win over the Mavericks before 2,733 at Sullivan Arena. Right winger Sean Wiles gave UAA a 1-0 lead in the first and left winger Tommy Grant made it 2-1 in the second. Centers Alex Hudson and Joey Martin scored for UNO. UAA leads the season series, 1-0-0.

Minnesota 5 @ Wisconsin 2 (WCHA): Right winger Taylor Mattson scored a pair of goals, including the winner, and Kent Patterson made 36 saves to lead the Golden Gophers over the host Badgers 5-2 before a Kohl Center crowd of 14,315. UM hit on 3-of-6 power-plays and also received two-point nights from left winger Mike Hoeffel (1g, 1a), defenseman Aaron Ness (2a) and right winger Pat White (1g, 1a). Defenseman Jake Gardiner and winger Jordy Murray scored PPGs for the Badgers. The four-game season series is tied 1-1-1.

Colorado College 5 @ Bemidji State 5 ot (WCHA): Right winger Ian Lowe had a goal and two assists for BSU and left winger Tim Hall had two goals and an assist for CC as the two teams played to a 5-5 (ot) tie before 3,650 at Sanford Center. The Tigers led 3-2 after one, 4-2 in the second and 5-4 in the third before Beavers' left winger Jordan George netted the game-tying goal at 17:05 of the third. The season series is tied at 0-0-1.

Minnesota Duluth 1 @ Minnesota State 3 (WCHA): Austin Lee made 40 saves in nets and defenseman Channing Boe scored the game-winning goal and added an assist as the host Mavericks prevailed 3-1 over the Bulldogs before 3,875 at Verizon Wireless Center. All the goals in the game came in the first period with Boe's power-play tally at 8:37 deciding the outcome. UMD outshot their hosts, 41-27, but were 0-of-4 on the power-play while MSU went 2-of-7. Left winger Mike Connolly scored his 20th goal of the season for the Bulldogs. Minnesota State leads the season series, 1-0-0.
